

## IAL Post Circuit Breaker Safe Management Info Sheet

This document contains the mandatory safe management measures during the post circuit-breaker period for learners returning to IAL to attend face-to-face sessions. Please adhere to the following safety measures at all times when you are in IAL.

### 1. SafeEntry App

Learners are required to check in and check out as they enter/exit our premises via the SafeEntry application. The QR codes are located at all entry/exit points at Level 5 and 7.

### 2. Daily temperature recording

Learners are required to have their temperature recorded daily at the temperature recording points located at the entry/exit points at Level 5 and 7.

### 3. Travel and Close Contact Declaration (Including Household Members Who Are Sick)

- a) Learners should not come to class if they are unwell and should see a doctor immediately, even if the symptoms are mild.
- b) Learners with sick household members (e.g. with fever, cough, sore throat, loss of sense of smell) must not come to class as a precaution, even if the learners themselves do not have symptoms.
- c) All non-essential overseas travel should be deferred.
- d) Please submit your travel and close contact declaration **before** your scheduled class via this [link](#).

### 4. Social Gathering and Safe Distancing

- a) Social gatherings during break time or after class among learners and/or their adult educators should be avoided.
- b) Learners and adult educators should continue to ensure safe distancing of at least one metre at all times.

## 5. Use of Face Masks and Face Shields

- a) Proper use of face masks (covering the nose and mouth) is mandatory while in our premises.
- b) Face shields are allowed only for specific groups of persons, in place of masks, as per Ministry of Health's guideline. <<https://www.moh.gov.sg/covid-19/fags>>
  - Persons who have health conditions that may result in breathing or other medical difficulties when a mask is worn for a prolonged period of time; and
  - Persons who are speaking to a group in a classroom or lecture-style setting, where they largely remain at the spot from which they are speaking, and are able to maintain a safe distance away from any other persons.
  - A face shield must be worn properly so that it covers the entire face, from the forehead to below the chin, wrapping around the sides of the face.

## 6. Communal Amenities & Refreshments

Please note the following:

- a) Refreshments will not be provided.
- b) Vending machines within IAL and plain water dispensers will continue to be available. Do bring your own water bottle.
- c) Common spaces in IAL will not be open to learners or visitors for use. Learners are advised to leave the premises right after the class ends.
