


BLENDED CURRICULUM AND LEARNING PLANS



- Design the curriculum include all the knowledge and skills to be taught in 3 modes of learning (classroom, e-learning and workplace)
- Plan the lessons decide on the expected learning outcomes and learning duration and select appropriate teaching strategies and methods

- **Design** learning activities and **develop** appropriate learning resources, e.g. presentation slides, infographics, handouts, worksheets, videos, e-Learning modules?



- Secure PHO BEFORE applying for the course
- PHO can be any business organisation with AT LEAST 10 employees to ensure reasonable sample size for meaningful needs analysis and curriculum design and development



✓ Full WSQ Advanced Certificate in Training and Assessment (ACTA) + WSQ ACLP M4 (Facilitate Workplace Learning)

WSQ DDDLP Prerequisites



WSQ DDDLP Prerequisites

- **2** Project Host Organisation (PHO)
 - PHO must be secured before applying for course
 - Have a minimum of 10 employees in the organization
 - (>) Work with you to find out learning gaps
 - > Reasonable sample size for meaningful data collection and analysis
 - Attain signed Letter of Consent before applying for course

WSQ DDDLP Important Policies

Withdrawal and refund

No refund of paid fees if learner withdraws midway from course

with no valid reason after course has commenced.

For full refund of paid fees, withdrawal request must be submitted

10 working days before course commences.

Class Rescheduling

Fall short of the **minimum of 75% attendance requirement** → Not allowed to take assessment of that module.

Rescheduling may be scheduled F.O.C **only for Recognized Absences** (terms and conditions with fee of \$110 before GST applies).

List of Recognised Absences

- Medical
- Reservist
- Court Appearance
- Bereavement of immediate family members

WSQ DDDLP Important Policies

Reassessment

Not-Yet Competent (NYC) → You can request for a **one-time** reassessment within 5 working days from the date of the last assessment with a reassessment fee of \$160 (before GST).

Maximum Candidature Period

You should complete your DDDLP within 2 years from the course start date failing which, your candidature will be terminated.

Full fees without funding will apply if you wish to re-enrol in the same course.

WSQ DDDLP Important Policies

Deferment

If you cannot complete the course for **reasons beyond your control**, you can submit a deferment application at an applicable **administrative fee of \$110 (before GST)** with valid, sufficient supporting documents.

Upon review, IAL's decision is final.

For approved applications, you must return within 1 year to complete the remaining modules.

Full fees without funding will apply if you wish to re-enrol in the same course past the 1-year deferment period.
